



## Crochet Beret in Silk Garden

### You Will Need

- 2 balls Silk Garden by Noro
- 5.00 mm crochet hook

### Abbreviations

sl st = slip stitch  
 ch = chain  
 tr = treble  
 dc = double crochet  
 trp = treble around post of treble (or 3 chain) in row below



### Instructions

Make 5 ch and join with a sl st to make a ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 3 (this will always be counted as 1 tr throughout pattern), 11 tr into ring. Sl st into the 3rd ch to complete round...12 trs.

**Round 2:** Ch3, trp (around 3 ch of row below) \*tr in next space, trp (around tr of row below), rep from \* till trp is worked on the last post before the round ends. Sl st into the 3rd chain to finish round. You will now have 24 trs (including trps).

**Round 3:** Ch 3, tr in next space, trp around next tr \*tr in next tr, tr next space, trp around next tr. Rep from \* till trp is worked on the last post before the round ends. Sl st into 3rd chain to finish round. You will now have 36 trs (including trps)

**Round 4:** Ch 3, tr in next tr, tr in next space, trp in next tr, \* tr in each of next 2 tr, tr in next space, trp in next tr. Rep from \* till trp is worked on the last post before the round ends. Sl st into 3rd chain to finish round. You will now have 48 trs. (including trps)

Repeat round 4, increasing 1 stitch in between trps each round until you have completed the round which has 9 trs between trps.

**Next round:** Ch 3, skip next tr, tr in next 7 trs, trp around next tr, \* skip next tr, tr in next 8 trs, trp in next tr. Rep from \* until round finished, joining with a slip stitch to 3rd chain to complete round.

Continue decreasing in this manner until there are 4 trs between trps.

**Next round:** 1 ch, \*dc into next tr. Rep from \* until round completed, joining round with sl st. Rep last round 3 more times. Fasten off.
