



## Daisy Crochet Pram Cover



### You Will Need

- 4 or 5 ply as desired:
- Colour 1 C1 - lime green x 2 50 gm balls pure wool
- Colour 2 C2 - white x 2 50 gm balls pure wool
- Colour 3 C3 - purple x 1 50 gm ball pure wool
- Colour 4 C4 - pale Blue x 1 50 gm ball pure wool
- Colour 5 C5 - buttercup x 150 gm ball pure wool

Hook size:

- 3.25 if using 4 ply, 3.75 if using 5 ply

## Abbreviations

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- rs = right side
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble
- crab stitch = double crochet worked from left to right.

## Measurements

- 75cm x 53cm approx.

## Instructions

### **C2 (White) Flower Squares – make 18**

Using 3.25 or 3.75 mm hook, and C1, make 4 ch and join with sl st to form a ring.

#### **Round 1:**

(Right Side), With C1, Ch1, 12 dc into ring, join with a sl st. Finish off.

#### **Round 2:**

Join C2 with a sl st in same st as joining sl st \* ch 6 **loosely**, working in top of loop only of each ch, tr in third ch from hook and in last 3 chs (petal), sl st in next dc, rep from \* to end of round, working last sl st in same sl st as joining previous round. Finish off. 12 Petals.

#### **Round 3:**

With RS facing, join in C3 with a sl st in 2 ch space at tip of any petal. Ch3 (counts as first tr), (2 tr, ch3, 3 tr) in same sp, ch 1, dc in 2 ch space at tip of next petal, ch 2, dc in 2 ch sp at tip of next petal, ch 1 \*(3 tr, ch 3, 3 tr) in 2 ch sp at tip of next petal, ch 1, dc in 2 ch sp at tip of next petal, ch 2, dc in 2 ch sp at tip of next petal, ch 1; rep from \* 2 more times, join with a sl st to the first tr. Finish off.

#### **Round 4:**

With RS facing, join C1 with a sl st in any 3 ch sp; ch 3, (2 tr ch 3, 3 tr) in same sp, ch 1, 2 tr in next 1 ch sp, htr in next dc, ch 1, 2 htr in next 2 ch sp, ch1, htr in next dc, 2 tr in next 1 ch sp, ch 1, \*(3 tr, ch3, 3 tr) in next 3 ch sp, ch 1, 2 tr in next 1 ch sp, htr in next dc, ch 1, 2 htr in next 2 ch sp, ch1, htr in next dc, 2 tr in next 1 ch sp, ch 1; rep from \* 2 more times. Join with a sl st to first tr. Finish off.

### **C4 (Blue) Flower Squares – make 9**


Repeat square instruction for C2 flowers, substituting C2 (white) in the second round with C4 (blue).

### **C5 (Buttercup) Flower Squares – make 8**

Repeat square instructions for C4 flowers, substituting C2 (white) in the second round with C5 (buttercup).

 To Complete

Decide which side of your work you prefer as your right side. One side sits in a convave manner, the other is puffed. With the right side of your work facing, assemble as laid out below and sew squares with a running stitch so that it sits flat. Sew in all ends.



**Edging:****Round 1:**

With the Right side facing, and using C1 and starting from half way along one side, dc evenly along edge until you reach the corner. 3dc into the corner. Repeat working dcs evenly along each side, working 3 dcs into each corner. Join with a slip stitch to complete round.

**Rounds 2 and 3,** ch1, then work as for round 1, making sure 3 dc's are worked into the 2nd stitch of the 3 corner dc's worked in previous round.

**Round 4:** ch1, then work a dc into each dc until you are 2 stitches before the corner stitch (the middle dc of the 3 dc's worked in the corner on previous round). \*Ch6, dc in next stitch, Ch10, dc in next stitch, Ch6, dc in next stitch, dc in every dc until you are 2 stitches before the next corner. Repeat from \* until last corner has been worked. Dc in each dc until the round is completed. Join with a slip stitch.

**Round 5:** ch1, then work a dc into each dc, until you reach the corner 6ch loop. \*Work 6 dc into the first loop, 10dc into the second loop and 6 dc into the 3rd loop, continue working a dc into each dc until you reach the next corner. Repeat from \* until the last corner has been worked. Continue working in dc's until the round is finished. Join with a slip stitch and finish off. Sew in ends.

Block work by pinning to shape, and covering with a damp cloth. Leave to dry naturally.
