



Hungarian Flower Rug



Once mastered, this is not a hard pattern at all. Whilst we have done our sample using 14 balls of 8 ply wool and this created a knee rug size of approx.. 110 x 110cm, you can make this rug any size you like...just keep adding rounds!

We have done our sample in shades of aqua, taupe and soft green. Whilst we only used 5 colours, there is no limit to the number of colours you choose to put in your rug...and a great way of using up scraps in the early rounds where only small quantities are used.

We have used Heirloom Easy Care 8ply - a standard 8ply, for our pattern. Quantities are based on 50 gm ball/95 metres per ball. Quantities required may vary when using other yarns.

You Will Need

5.00 mm crochet hook

Tension: 1st 2 rounds should measure approx 10cm X 10 cm. Tension is not critical to the end result except that the quantities of yarn required to complete the rug could be incorrect.

Size of rug: approx 110 X 110cm



Abbreviations used in this pattern:

ch chain

dtr double treble

dc double crochet

4dtrc 4 double treble cluster : work 4 dtr but leaving the last loop of each dtr on the hook until all 4 have been worked..thus after working 4 dtrs you will have 5 loops on the hook. Draw yarn through all 5 loops.

8dtrc 8 double treble cluster : work 8 dtr but leaving the last loops of each dtr on the hook until all 8 have been worked..thus after working 8 dtrs, you will have 9 loops on the hook. Draw yarn though all 9 loops.

To begin...

Using C1 and 5.00mm hook, chain 5 and join with a slip stitch to form a circle.

Round 1: *ch 4, **4dtrc** into ring, work 1 chain (we will call this a "locking chain" to complete the cluster and to identify the correct stitch to work into on the next round), ch4, 1 dc into ring* .repeat from * to * 3 more times. 4 **dtrc** clusters.

Round 2: *2 ch, 12 dtr into "locking chain", 2 ch, 1 dc into dc* repeat from * to * 3 more times, fasten off and break off yarn. 4 fans

Round 3: Cluster Round. Change Colour.

Join C2 and dc into the space between the 8th and 9th dtr of any of the 4 fans.

4 ch, work **8dtrc** over the last 4 dtrs of this fan and 1st 4 dtrs of next fan, ch 1 (locking chain).

4 ch, 1 dc into space between 4th and 5th dtr, (corner to be worked) 4 ch, 4dtrc over the next 4 dtr, 1 ch (locking chain) 4 ch, *dc into space between 8th and 9th dtr, 4 ch, work **8dtrc** over the last 4 dtrs of this fan and 1st 4 dtrs of next fan, ch 1 (locking chain), 4 ch, 1 dc into space between 4th and 5th dtr (corner to be worked) 4 ch, 4dtrc over the next 4 dtr, 1 chain (locking chain) 4 ch*. Repeat from * to * 2 times more, dc into space between 8th and 9th dtr of next petal to complete the round. Do not break off yarn.

Round 4: Fan Round.

2 ch, 8 dtr into "locking chain" of next cluster, 2 ch, 1 dc into next dc, 2 ch, 12 dtr into locking chain of corner cluster, 2 ch, 1 dc into next dc repeat from * to * 3 more times. Fasten off and break yarn.

Round 5: Cluster Round

Join C3 and dc into the space between the 8th and 9th dtr of any of the 4 corner clusters.

*4ch, work **8dtrc** over the last 4 dtrs of this fan and 1st 4 dtrs of next fan, ch 1 (locking chain), 4 ch, 1 dc into space between 4th and 5th dtr, 4 ch, work **8dtrc** over the last 4 dtrs of this fan and 1st 4 dtrs of next fan, ch 1 (locking chain), 4 ch, 1 dc into space between 4th and 5th dtr, (corner to be worked) 4 ch, 4dtrc over the next 4 dtr, 1 chain (locking chain) 4 ch, dc in space between the 8th and 9th dtr, repeat from * until the end of round is worked. Do not break off yarn.

Round 6: Fan Round

*2 ch, 8 dtr into "locking chain" of next cluster, 2 ch, 1 dc into next dc, 2 ch 8 dtr into "locking chain" of next cluster, 2 ch, 1 dc into next dc, 2 ch, 12 dtr into lock chain of corner cluster, 2 ch, 1 dc into next dc repeat from * till end of round. Fasten off and break yarn.













Row 5 Cluster Round and Row 6 Fan Round are repeated - every Cluster round you will be increasing by 1 8dtrc each straight side, before a 4dtrc is worked in each of the corners.

Colour is changed according to sequence hereunder at the commencement of every Cluster Round. Fan Round completes the flower in the same colour.

Use the table below to record the colours you are using – makes it much easier to follow the colour changes correctly.

You are up to Round 7 and C2.
