

# JACKET WITH HOOD

■■■ Intermediate Knitting

## MEASUREMENTS

Years	2	4	6	8	10
To Fit Chest	cm 55	60	65	70	75
Actual Size	cm 65	70	75	80	85
Length (approx)	cm 38	42	46	50	54
Sleeve Length	cm 25	30	35	40	42

## PATONS JET PIXEL 12 PLY 50g balls

Quantity	7	9	10	12	13
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Use only the yarns specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters.

Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair 5.50mm (UK 5) knitting needles, and two 5.00mm (UK 6) **double-pointed** knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- 3 buttons.
- wool needle for sewing seams.
- piece of cardboard 10cm wide for tassel.

## TENSION

16.5 sts and 22 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 5.50mm needles.

To work a tension square, using 5.50mm needles, cast on 24 sts. Work 34 rows stocking st. Cast off loosely.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

## BACK

Using 5.50mm needles, cast on **58** (62-66-70-74) sts.

**1st row** – K2, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**2nd row** – P2, \* K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form rib.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times, dec 2 sts evenly across last row ... **56** (60-64-68-72) sts, 12 rows rib in all.

Working in stocking st for rem, work **40** (48-54-58-66) rows.

### Shape Armholes –

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **50** (54-58-62-66) sts.

**Next row** – K1, K2tog, knit to last 3 sts, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1 ... **48** (52-56-60-64) sts.

Dec one st (as before) at each end of every foll alt row until **44** (48-52-54-56) sts rem.

Work **21** (25-27-29-29) rows without further shaping.

### Shape Back Neck –

**Next row** – K11 (12-14-15-16), cast off next **22** (24-24-24-24) sts, knit to end.

Cont on these **11** (12-14-15-16) sts for left side of back neck.

Dec one st at neck edge in next 2 rows ...

**9** (10-12-13-14) sts.

### Shape Shoulder –

Cast off **5** (5-6-7-7) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem **4** (5-6-6-7) sts.

With wrong side facing, join yarn to rem

**11** (12-14-15-16) sts for right side of back neck.

Dec one st at neck edge in next row ... **10** (11-

**13-14-15**) sts.

### Shape Shoulder –

**Next row** – Cast off **5** (5-6-7-7) sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem **4** (5-6-6-7) sts.

## LEFT FRONT

Using 5.50mm needles, cast on **31** (35-35-39-39) sts.

**1st row** – K2, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**2nd row** – P3, \* K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form rib for Left Front.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times, dec **1** (3-1-3-1) sts evenly in last row ... **30** (32-34-36-38) sts, 12 rows rib in all.

Working in stocking st for rem, work **40** (48-54-58-66) rows.

### Shape Armhole –

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row ... **27** (29-31-33-35) sts.

Work 1 row.

**Next row** – K1, K2tog, knit to end ... **26** (28-30-32-34) sts.

Dec one st (as before) at armhole edge in every foll alt row until **24** (26-28-29-30) sts rem.

Work **14** (16-18-20-20) rows without further shaping.

### Shape Neck –

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row ... **19** (21-23-24-25) sts.

Dec one st at end of next row.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row ... **14** (16-18-19-20) sts.

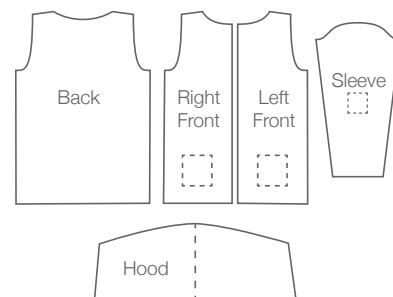
Dec one st at neck edge in next 3 rows, then in every foll alt row until **10** (11-13-14-15) sts rem.

Work 1 row.

### Shape Shoulder –

**Next row** – Cast off **5** (5-6-7-7) sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem **4** (5-6-6-7) sts.



## RIGHT FRONT

Using 5.50mm needles, cast on **31** (35-35-39-39) sts.

**1st row** – K3, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**2nd row** – P2, \* K2, P2, rep from \* to last st, P1.

Last 2 rows form rib for Right Front.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times, dec **1** (3-1-3-1) sts evenly in last row ... **30** (32-34-36-38) sts, 12 rows rib in all.

Working in stocking st for rem, work **20** (26-30-30-36) rows.

**Next row** – K2, K2tog, yfwd (buttonhole), knit to end.

Work **19** (21-23-27-29) rows.

**Next row** – K2, K2tog, yfwd, knit to end ... 2 buttonholes.

### Shape Armhole –

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row ... **27** (29-31-33-35) sts.

**Next row** – Knit to last 3 sts, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1 ... **26** (28-30-32-34) sts.

Dec one st (as before) at armhole edge in every foll alt row until **24** (26-28-29-30) sts rem.

Work **13** (15-17-19-19) rows without further shaping.

**Next row** – K2, K2tog, yfwd, knit to end ... 3 buttonholes.

Work 1 row.

### Shape Neck –

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row ... **19** (21-23-24-25) sts.

Dec one st at end of next row.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row ... **14** (16-18-19-20) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in next 4 rows, then in every foll alt row until **9** (10-12-13-14) sts rem.

### Shape Shoulder –

Cast off **5** (5-6-7-7) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem **4** (5-6-6-7) sts.

## SLEEVES

Using 5.50mm needles, cast on **30** (34-34-34-38) sts.

Work 12 rows rib as for Back, dec **0** (2-0-0-2) sts evenly in last row ... **30** (32-34-34-36) sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st.

**3rd row** – K2, **M1**, knit to last 2 sts, **M1**, K2 ... **32** (34-36-36-38) sts.

Cont in stocking st, inc one st (as before) at each end of every foll **10th** (14th-**16th**-14th-**16th**) row until there are **38** (40-42-44-46) sts.

Cont without further shaping until Sleeve measures **25** (30-35-40-42) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

### Shape Top –

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **34** (36-38-40-42) sts.

**Next row** – K1, K2tog, knit to last 3 sts, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1 ... **32** (34-36-38-40) sts.

Dec one st (as before) at each end of every foll alt row until **22** (22-**26**-26-**26**) sts rem.

**Next row** – P1, P2tog tbl, purl to last 3 sts, P2tog, P1 ... **20** (20-**24**-24-**24**) sts.

Dec one st (as before) at each end of every row until 16 sts rem.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 8 sts.

## HOOD

Using 5.50mm needles, cast on **100** (104-**108**-110-**114**) sts.

Work 4 rows stocking st.

Cont in stocking st, dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 10th row until **92** (96-**100**-102-**106**) sts rem.

Cont without further shaping until Hood measures **19** (19-**20**-20-**21**) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

### Shape Back of Hood –

**1st row** – Cast off **12** (11-**10**-11-**13**) sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

**2nd row** – Cast off **12** (11-**10**-11-**13**) sts, purl to last 2 sts, P2tog ... **66** (72-**78**-78-**78**) sts.

**3rd row** – Cast off **10** (11-**12**-12-**12**) sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

**4th row** – Cast off **10** (11-**12**-12-**12**) sts, purl to last 2 sts, P2tog.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows once, then 3rd row once.

Cast off rem **11** (12-**13**-13-**13**) sts (on wrong side).

## FRONT POCKETS (MAKE 2)

Using 5.50mm needles, cast on **15** (15-**15**-18-**18**) sts.

Work **12** (12-**14**-14-**16**) rows stocking st, inc **1** (1-**1**-2-**2**) sts evenly in last row ... **16** (16-**16**-20-**20**) sts.

**Next row** – K3, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**Next row** – P3, \* K2, P2, rep from \* to last st, P1.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times ... 12 rows rib in all.

Cast off in rib.

## SLEEVE POCKET

Using 5.50mm needles, cast on **10** (10-**12**-12-**12**) sts.

Work **12** (12-**14**-14-**14**) rows stocking st.

Cast off.

## FRONT AND HOOD EDGING

**NOTE** – We recommend using mattress stitch to sew up your jacket (see page 42). Join shoulder seams. Join centre back seam of hood. Sew hood in position, placing seam at centre back of jacket. Using two 5.00mm **double-pointed** needles, cast on 3 sts. With right side facing, and beginning at lower corner of right front edge, work attached i-cord edging (see page 34) evenly along right front edge, front edge of hood, then left front edge. Break off yarn, thread end through sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

## TO MAKE UP

With a slightly damp cloth and warm iron press lightly on wrong side. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Stitch sleeve and front pockets in position as pictured. Make a tassel and attach to hood, as pictured. Sew on buttons.
